

Yearly RV Maintenance Schedule

PRIOR TO CAMPING SEASON

- Check AC unit for function and clean
- Full roof inspection
- Check life in batteries
- Check for water leaks & dewinterize
- Check brakes and hubs
- Check slides for function and seals for rot
- Check all appliances for function on electric and propane sources
- Ensure your water heater is working properly
- Fill propane tanks
- Change batteries in all detectors
- Check all electrical fuses and wires for any damage
- Check all landing gear and stabilizing jacks for proper function

DURING CAMPING SEASON

- Clean awning every 3-4 trips
- Flush your black tank every other trip at a minimum
- Keep an eye out for any water leaks
- Ensure all appliances work properly on every trip
- Brush off slides every trip before retracting them

AFTER CAMPING SEASON

- Check AC unit for function and clean
- Full roof inspection
- Check life in batteries
- Check for water leaks & winterize
- Check slides for function and seals for rot
- Check all electrical fuses and wires for any damage
- Check tires for tread and wear
- Drain all your holding tanks and low point drains before winterization
